

## **Middle School Supply List 2020 - 2021**

Be aware that the following was written in May 2020, so keep in mind that what is needed may change based on how the school year ends up operating due to COVID-19.

The middle school teachers want your child to be successful; one key factor in achieving this is organization. We would like you and your child to discuss what might be the best approach to organizing papers and work. There are four options we recommend because we have seen a significant percentage of students be successful using the following tools.

Pick one of the options below:

- A spiral bound notebook that has a pocket for each of the 6 subjects in middle school
- A three-ring binder divided into 6 sections, with pockets for handouts, or a three hole punch to organize handouts
- Folders for each class for handouts and lined paper to take notes
- Accordion file folder with at least six pockets. You will also add lined paper

The deciding factor in which of these systems to pick is your child and how well he/she will stick to one of these systems.

We DO NOT recommend large rolling backpacks. With limited space and social distancing, we suggest a smaller backpack or tote bag to help organize and carry for each class.

Make sure that your child has reliable access to the internet and a device with camera and microphone to complete work digitally when at home for various assignments.

**Please be aware that some of the supplies below will need to be purchased throughout the year as needed to be used at home or at school.**

**Supplies your child will need all year:**

College Ruled Lined paper

Graphing paper, 8 1/2 X 11, any size squares per inch

Pens, black or blue; students should **always** have two available. Student work should always be done in these basic colors, unless directed otherwise by a teacher

Pencils (students should **always** have two available) - avoid plastic coated pencils as they break the sharpeners

Red or other color pens for correcting

1 set markers (either thick or thin is fine)

1 scientific calculator

1 pair scissors

1 bottle glue and 1 glue stick

Headphone set with a microphone, for use with Rosetta Stone (Must be compatible with iPad:

Bluetooth or 3.5 mm Headphone Plug) - Clearly labeled with child's name

New American Bible (one time purchase in 6<sup>th</sup> grade)

Personal small container of hand sanitizer

Optional items: sticky notes, index cards to use as flashcards (lined or unlined for vocabulary flashcards), small stapler with staples

**Please label all above supplies with your child's name**

**Please bring these the first day of school.**

1 box of tissues

1 roll of paper towels

1 container of Clorox wipes

1 box of paper masks
